...as leaders, we must articulate a clear and compelling vision, create a culture for innovation and partnership, and practice adaptive leadership skills...


...we must move from program thinking to systems change thinking as the only way to achieve the ultimate outcomes we strive for, which are to ultimately:


- reduce the number of people living in poverty,

Leadership Matters

- Have a values-driven vision that provides you and others with a "head and heart" connection
- Listen musically and think analytically
- Be disruptive by nature, remembering it is through ambiguity that new thinking and creativity are found (this isn't easy)
- Collaborate widely, partner deeply, and share governance
- Educate and engage; then repeat, repeat, repeat!

Organizational Hardwiring

- Data sharing and data analytics our next frontier
- We do what we measure
- Alignment of philosophy and values through all aspects of organization
- Provide opportunities for continuous learning and critical thinking based on data, science, and daily experiences
- Leverage and build the capacities that are necessary
- Create a broader understanding of "resource" generation both internally and externally

TOXIC STRESS IN CHICDREN HAS DECREASED, AND HEALTHY RELATIONSHIPS HAVE INCREASED.


Practice: Every Person Every Time!

- Practitioners need a broader context for the importance and impact of their work beyond program outcomes
- Contracts and budget alignment is key
- Understand that community capacity needs to be built and is foundational to this work
- Practice must be aligned to the science and person, family-centered, and strengths-based engagement values

Policy: The BIG P and little p

- We are all policymakers and advocates every day
- Continuously align all policies across child and adult programs and interfacing systems to ACEs science and toxic stress mitigation
- Reframe and reposition health and human services from transactional to transformational – don't "otherize"
- We must turn the ship with new financing models for human services
